For our kit-sets to meet site specific requirements and the **BRANZ** standards, you will need to engage an Engineer and an Architectural Designer. Modifications will be required to the 'raw' kit-set design.

Just like building any home, you will need to ensure the building's sructural integrity meets your site specific requirements which forms part of the NZ building code. You'll need to plan for power, water and waste systems, either on grid or off-grid (e.g. solar, rainwater, composting or septic systems).

Customised mobile or transportable units must also meet NZTA standards if moved on public roads.


